

Robinson Crusoe is the name of a book by Daniel Defoe. Daniel Defoe was born in 1660. His father was a butcher, and Daniel Defoe worked at a number of trades before he started to write, at the age of forty. He wrote poems and occasionally wrote criticisms of the Government. For some time he was sent to prison. When he was nearly sixty he wrote the story of Robinson Crusoe. It was a great success, and has been popular with children ever since. It is the first great English novel. In this short piece from the book , Robinson Crusoe tells us how we became shipwrecked.
