

The development of Jane Eyre's character is central to the novel. From the beginning, Jane possesses a sense of her self-worth and dignity, a commitment to justice and principle, a trust in God, and a passionate disposition. Her integrity is continually tested over the course of the novel, and Jane must learn to balance the frequently conflicting aspects of herself so as to find contentment.

In the early chapters, Bronte establishes the young Jane's character through her confrontation with John and Mrs. Reed. Jane's good hearted, but strong-willed character and her determination becomes apparent. From the beginning, Jane Eyre stands against the class difference of the nineteenth century Victorian society. As a penniless orphan, she is forced to live on the charity of others. In the early chapters, Jane is introduced as a second class citizen. She feels inferior to the others.

Her life in Lowood begins her change. The experiences she has with cruel teachers, harsh conditions of life like scares of food and space, and the tyranny of Mrs. Brocklehurst sharpens her intelligence, talent and self – assurance. She is neither religious nor irreligious. She is disgusted about Brocklehurst's hypocritical disposition of religion and fascinated by Helen Burn's faith in God. Yet she questions whether the God exists.

Miss Temple's kind gesture has a great impact on Jane's character building. She kindly listens to her story and calls for clarification from Mr. Loyd and rectifies in public the damage caused by Mr. Brocklehurst.

Jane begins her third phase of life at Thornfield. She begins her independent life as a governess. This is where the turning point of her life occurs. Jane experiences some unnatural experiences in Thornfield Hall.
