


What are the Perfect Tenses?

actions.




• It covers the past perfect tense, the present perfect tense, and the future perfect tense.





Past Perfect Tense





Past Present Future


Forming the Past Perfect Tense

had + past participle









Present Perfect Tense

Has/Have + Past Participle

Activity that started in the past and continues to the present.

Forming the Present Perfect Tense

has/have + past participle







Future Perfect Tense


Will Have + Past Participle



Past Present Future

Forming the Future Perfect Tense

will have + past participle
