### Lesson Note

#### Relative Pronoun

**A Relative Pronoun** is used to connect a clause or phrase to a noun or pronoun. We use them every day.

- With the most common relative pronouns being: **who** , **whom** , **which** and **that**.
- We use '**who**, **whom** and **whose**' for people.
- We use '**which**' for animals and things.
- We use '**that**' for people, animal or things.
- We use '**where**' to refer to places.
- The relative pronoun '**when**' is used to refer to the time.

Eg: 1. The girl **who** joined our class last week, is very clever.

2. The girl **whom** I met at the party is a singer.

3. I have a friend **whose** father is a magician.

4. Noodles is a food **which** we eat every day.
