## Relative Pronoun

A Relative Pronoun is used to connect a clause or phrase to a noun or pronoun. We use them every day.

- With the most common relative pronouns being: who, whom, which and that.
- We use 'who, whom and whose' for people.
- We use 'which' for animals and things.
- We use 'that' for people, animal or things.
- We use 'where' to refer to places.
- The relative pronoun 'when' is used to refer to the time.
  - Eg: 1. The girl who joined our class last week, is very clever.
    - 2. The girl **whom** I met at the party is a singer.
    - 3. I have a friend **whose** father is a magician.
    - 4. Noodles is a food **which** we eat every day.
    - 5. Penguin is a bird **that** cannot fly.
